This is to advise you that you probably are indeed the owner of a rare automobile. According to our records, Ford built only eight 1967 Mercury Comet Cyclones with 427-CID V-8 engines.

I say probably only because our records show only a Mercury Comet Cyclone model -- not a Mercury Cyclone. For right now, I'm assuming that you simply omitted the word Comet in your letter.

I can't verify the build date through the serial number, but it was built at Ford's Lorain (Ohio) Assembly Plant. The serial number also confirms that it is a two-door hardtop with bucket seats and the V-8 performance engine.

Thank you for writing. I'm happy I could be of assistance.
